Broadband Build-Out Requirements

Objective and Rationale:

The overall objective is to establish a reasonable build-out requirement for the number of rate-of-return (RoR) support-eligible locations where a minimum of 10/1 M capability will be made available. Each company electing model-based support will retain its existing (legacy) support amount and will receive additional funding through Connect America fund (CAF) reserves over at least 10 years.¹ The amount of support available for additional broadband deployment is dependent on the amount of CAF reserves available and the number of study areas that voluntarily elect model-based support.

The number of eligible locations required to be served with 10/1 M-capable infrastructure will be less than the total eligible locations because the model (A-CAM) is not fully funded and the support per eligible location likely will be capped at a dollar amount yet to be finalized by the Commission.² The eligible locations to which a company must deploy 10/1 M capability should be based on the A-CAM modeled cost characteristics of each company, additional support funding available through CAF reserves, and the current build-out level of the company.³ This calculation must be performed on a company-by-company basis because each company's cost curve is different and the cost of the yet to be upgraded locations is dependent on how much broadband deployment has already been undertaken by the company.

This Deployment Requirement Calculation assumes that only CAF reserve funding is available to deploy 10/1 M capable plant, since RoR legacy funding is, by its nature, recouping past investment and operating and maintenance expenses associated with that investment. The Deployment Requirement Calculation maximizes the number of locations with 10/1 M capability for a particular company within a state. Locations that are not fully funded at 10/1 M cost will remain on a reasonable request standard. Because the A-CAM model does not provide the cost of alternative technologies, the model cannot be used to establish deployment requirements for

¹ Companies receiving less model-based support than legacy support will not receive an allocation of CAF reserve dollars. The industry is working on a transition plan for those companies.

² Illustrative Run 2.3 assumed a cap of \$230 per location, and other runs considered funding limits.

³ For companies with multiple study areas within a state, the build-out requirement is calculated at a statewide level rather than a study area level. A company can meet the build-out requirement by deploying 10/1 M-capable facilities in any study area it deems appropriate as long as the overall statewide build-out requirement is met. This approach is reasonable given that the Commission has indicated it likely will require a statewide election of model-based support.

other speed levels; thus the reasonable request standard remains the most appropriate for locations not fully funded at 10/1 M cost.

Deployment Requirement Calculation Methodology:

The A-CAM can be used to estimate where 10/1 M infrastructure exists today and where it likely will be constructed in the future.⁴ The calculation method assumes that a company first deploys broadband throughout its lowest cost census block eligible to receive support,⁵ then proceeds to its next highest cost census block eligible to receive support and so on until all census blocks are served or all available funding is exhausted.⁶ The calculation steps are as follows:

1. Determine each company's share of CAF reserves. (Attachment B recommends a method to allocate CAF reserves.) The company's share of CAF reserves times the company-specific percentage of capital expenditures in A-CAM is the company's capital build-out obligation.⁷
2. Sort the company's A-CAM census blocks in order of increasing census block cost.
3. For any census block eligible to receive support,⁸ calculate its capital expenditure cost, which is equal to the company's A-CAM capital expenditure cost for the census block that exceeds the benchmark of \$52.50.

⁴ While Form 477 data has been updated, concerns remain regarding data accuracy. Thus, a challenge process may be necessary to accurately determine eligible locations.

⁵ If the cost per location of a census block is greater than \$52.50 and it is not served by any unsubsidized competitor, the census block is eligible to receive support.

⁶ This assumption was made to simplify the analysis but will not always be accurate since networks are not constructed by census block. Not all customers in a specific census block will be served at the same time. Furthermore, companies replace infrastructure when it no longer provides adequate service; thus the infrastructure in some high cost census blocks may be replaced prior to replacing infrastructure in low cost census blocks.

⁷ Previously, this proposal was submitted using the average capital expenditure cost in A-CAM, or 43.3 percent of the cost of the census block. Subsequently, it was determined that this percentage should include taxes associated with the return on investment, or 52.1 percent of the cost of the census block. This proposal further refines the percentage to be based on company-specific capital expenditure costs.

⁸ See Note 4 for the definition of an eligible census block.

Broadband Build-Out Requirements

Thus, for *Census Block_i*:

Support Used in Census Block_i = *Capital Expenditure Cost_i* = *Company Specific CapEx Percentage_i* × *Number of Subscribers_i* × (*Cost per Subscriber_i* – \$52.50)

Since A-CAM provides the number of eligible locations in each census block, and the average cost of those locations, it is known how much capital build-out obligation is necessary to serve the eligible locations in this census block.

4. Starting with the lowest cost eligible census block, sum the capital build-out obligation and the number of locations for each eligible census block until the company's entire aforementioned capital build-out obligation has been used.

5. The company must deploy infrastructure to 95 percent of the eligible locations receiving support, as determined in Step 4.⁹

An estimate of the total number of locations by company that would be built to under this methodology accompanies this attachment as Table 1.¹⁰ It would be appropriate to request that CostQuest make programming changes in order to perform the calculations. Without the services of CostQuest it is impossible to precisely calculate deployment requirements because the costs in the posted data set are rounded to the nearest \$5 to protect the confidentiality of the underlying data.

⁹ As discussed above, companies may not actually build to lowest cost census blocks first. In addition, the A-CAM does not identify the specific cost for any particular location; rather, it is a relative cost indicator. Thus, the 95% factor is used to account for the difference between A-CAM costs and actual construction costs as well as actual build-out patterns.

¹⁰ The table assumes that a company will elect model-based support if its model support exceeds its legacy support by \$1.
