## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be immediate family members of an owner, board of director, manager or employee of a WTA Category I or Category II Member Company in good standing. (*“Family members” are sons, daughters and stepchildren including legal guardian or adopted status.*)
2. Applicants must be a high school senior of an accredited public, parochial, home school or private high school for the current 2023-2024 academic year.
3. Applicants must be entering an accredited junior community college, technical/trade school, four year college or university.

## ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS

Selections for the scholarship awards will be based on these factors:

- » Grades in high school
- » Leadership qualities and character
- » Community and other outside activities
- » Handwritten essay of goals and letters of recommendation

## SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURE AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must fully complete a current academic or trade school scholarship application form. Please include a photograph.
2. Completed applications must be submitted no later than **March 1, 2024**.
3. Applicants must provide a copy of their high school scholastic record, stating cumulative grade point average.
4. Applicants must provide a copy of their senior class academic schedule and first semester grades for the 2023-2024 academic year.
5. Applicants must provide a personal evaluation/recommendation from their principal or teacher of secondary school.
6. Applicants must provide a letter of recommendation from an employer, official, civic or religious leader of the community the applicant resides in.
7. Applicants must provide an essay stating their educational goals and the contribution they plan to make to society.
8. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
9. Applications are only accepted electronically
