

WTA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE!

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must be immediate family members of an owner, board member, manager, or employee of a **WTA Category I or Category II Broadband member company** in good standing. Family members include sons, daughters, and stepchildren, including those under legal guardianship or adopted status.
2. Applicants must be high school seniors during the 2024-2025 academic year, attending an accredited public, parochial, private, or home school.
3. Applicants must be entering an accredited junior or community college, technical/trade school, or college or university in the fall of 2025. Those planning mission trips or gap years instead of beginning school in fall 2025 are not eligible and should not apply for this scholarship.
4. All application documents must be uploaded in PDF format. All required information must be completed accurately; incomplete applications or those submitted in formats other than PDF will be disqualified. Please carefully review your submissions to ensure they meet these requirements.

ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS:

Selections for the scholarship awards will be based on the following criteria:

- » High school grades
- » Leadership qualities and character
- » Community and other extracurricular activities
- » Student essay on educational goals
- » Letters of recommendation

SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURE AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must fully complete the current academic or trade school scholarship application form, including a photograph.
2. Scholarship applications will open on December 2, 2024. **Completed applications must be submitted no later than February 21, 2025.**
3. Applicants must include a copy of their high school transcripts, including their cumulative GPA. Any AP, IB, or honors classes should be clearly listed. If these classes were not available at the high school, please indicate this.
4. Applicants must provide a copy of their senior class schedule and first semester grades for the 2024-2025 school year.
5. A personal evaluation or recommendation from a principal or teacher is required.
6. Applicants must provide a letter of recommendation from an employer, community official, or religious leader.
7. An essay detailing educational goals and intended contributions to society must be included.
8. Applications will only be accepted electronically.
9. All documents must be submitted in PDF format. Incomplete applications or those in formats other than PDF will be disqualified. Review your submissions to ensure they meet these requirements.
10. Applicants must apply for a scholarship that aligns with their chosen academic or trade program. If an application is submitted for the wrong scholarship, it will be disqualified.

SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT AND AWARDS:

1. Scholarship awards range from \$750 to \$2,500.
2. Winners will be announced by May 1, 2025.
3. To receive the scholarship, winners must provide proof of registration, a student ID number, and the school's mailing address by August 15, 2025. Failure to submit all required information by the deadline will result in forfeiture of the scholarship award without further notice.
4. Scholarship awards will be mailed directly to the educational institution.
